
Comprehensive Approach

2011 Solomon Islands Government decided to:


- Address CCA, CCM & DRM in a coordinated and collaborative approach
- Have national agencies, NGOs & development partners to collaborate
- Cross-sectoral using a ridge to reef approach
- Test in one province
- Choiseul





Choiseul Province




- **Local name:** Lauru
- **Land area:** Main island (3,106 km²), two small islands Wagina and Rob Roy
- **Population:** 26,372 (2009), Melanesians and resettled Micronesians
- **Capital:** Provincial headquarters on Taro Island
- **Wards:** 14, each with an elected member to the Provincial Assembly (headed by Premier)
- **Economy:** logging, income at community level - copra, local sale of root crops and fish, small scale sawmilling, seaweed farming & mining

- Linking socio-economic & environmental issues
- Integrated planning, implementation & management

Progress of Choiseul Integrated Climate Change Programme (CHICCHAP)


- Joint V&A assessment and 26 village profiles
- Multi-stakeholder and multi-sectoral planning workshop in Taro (144 participants, majority from local communities)
- CHICCHAP implementation plan – based on V&A report
- Agreement signed between SPC, SPREP, PACCSAP, GIZ, UNDP and TNC
- Partners Advisory and Implementation Group (PAIG) & endorsed TOR
- Joint 2013 work plan developed
- Draft Cabinet paper on CHICCHAP awaiting submission
- Implementing agencies - joint field assessments and programme implementation

- Support the Choiseul Provincial Steering Committee
- Submit Cabinet paper in CHICCHAP to PS MECDM
- Produce PR & awareness materials on CHICCHAP
