# CDCRM RATIONALE

- Program developed in 2011
- Government led initiative
- Lessons learnt from the 2009 Tsunami
- Village based preparedness / awareness
- Village level disaster planning
- Household / baseline surveys
- Standardised approaches to building community based resilience
- Delivery to 361 villages in Samoa



# CDCRM FRAMEWORK

- Disaster and Emergency Act 2007
- National Disaster Management Plan:
  - Role of the Community
  - Local population are the first responders

# IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES

- Program requires the identification and appointment of an Implementing Agency (IA)
- Formalised agreement between IA & Government through the MNRE
- IAs = Red Cross Society, ADRA



# RESPONSE TEAMS

- Developed and identified Village Response Teams:
  - First Aid
  - Evacuation
  - **Warning**
  - Search and Recue
  - Shelter Management
  - Water & Sanitation
  - Disaster & Climate Committee
- Disaster Advisory Committee (DAC)  
Response Agencies provide training

# PARTNERSHIP – FINPAC PROJECT / METEOROLOGY

- CDCRM used to Implement the FinPac Project at the village level
- Warning Team
  - Project Objectives fits well (FinPac)
  - Awareness & understanding in weather & climate information
  - Meteorology personnel facilitate session on weather and climate information
    - Basics on weather terms – hydrological, geological
    - Difference between climate & weather
    - 2 seasons and potential disasters
