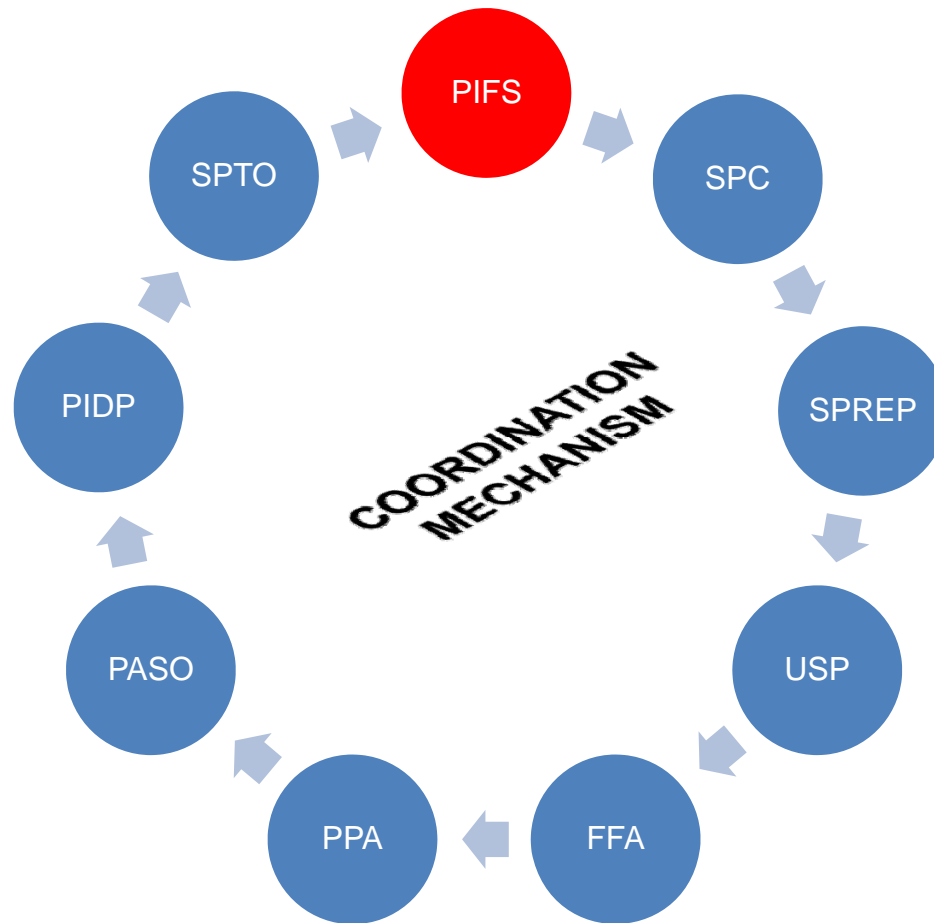

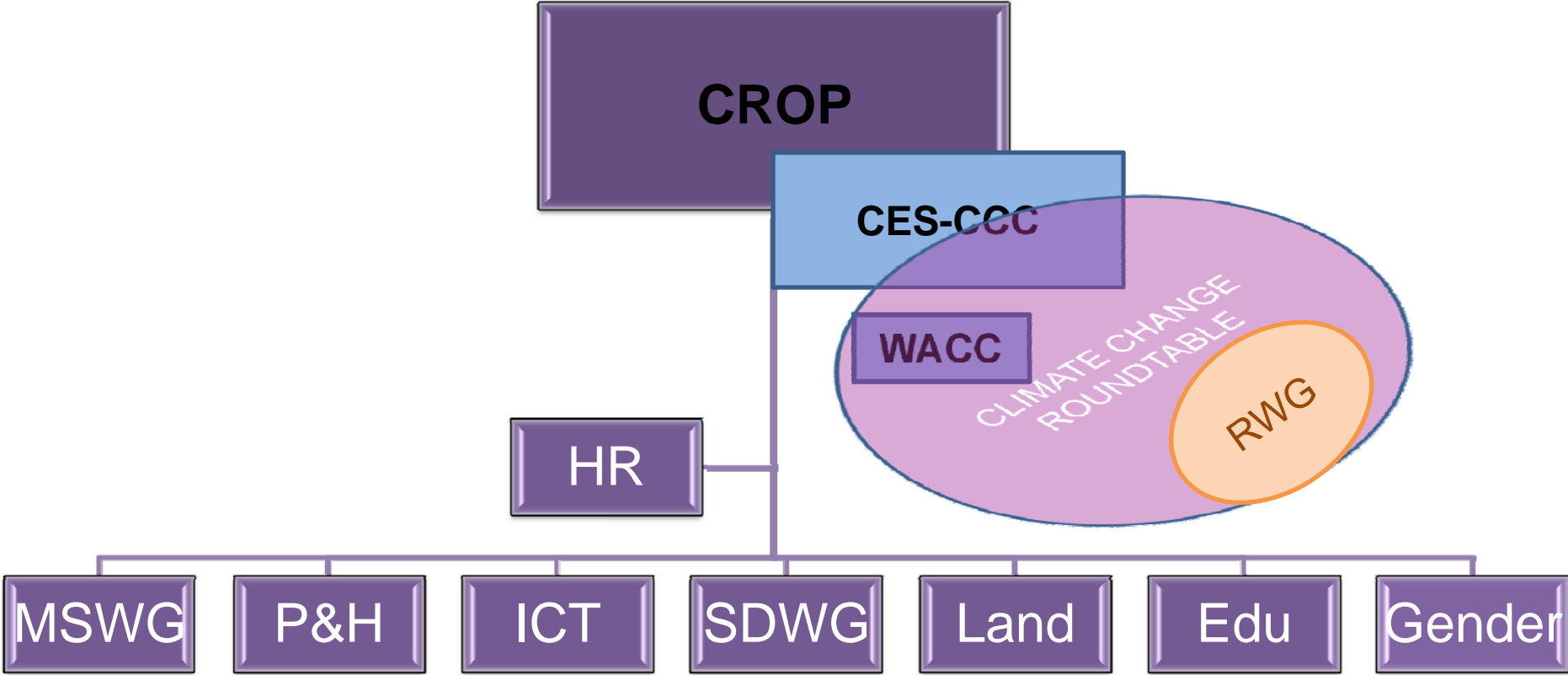
Existing regional processes



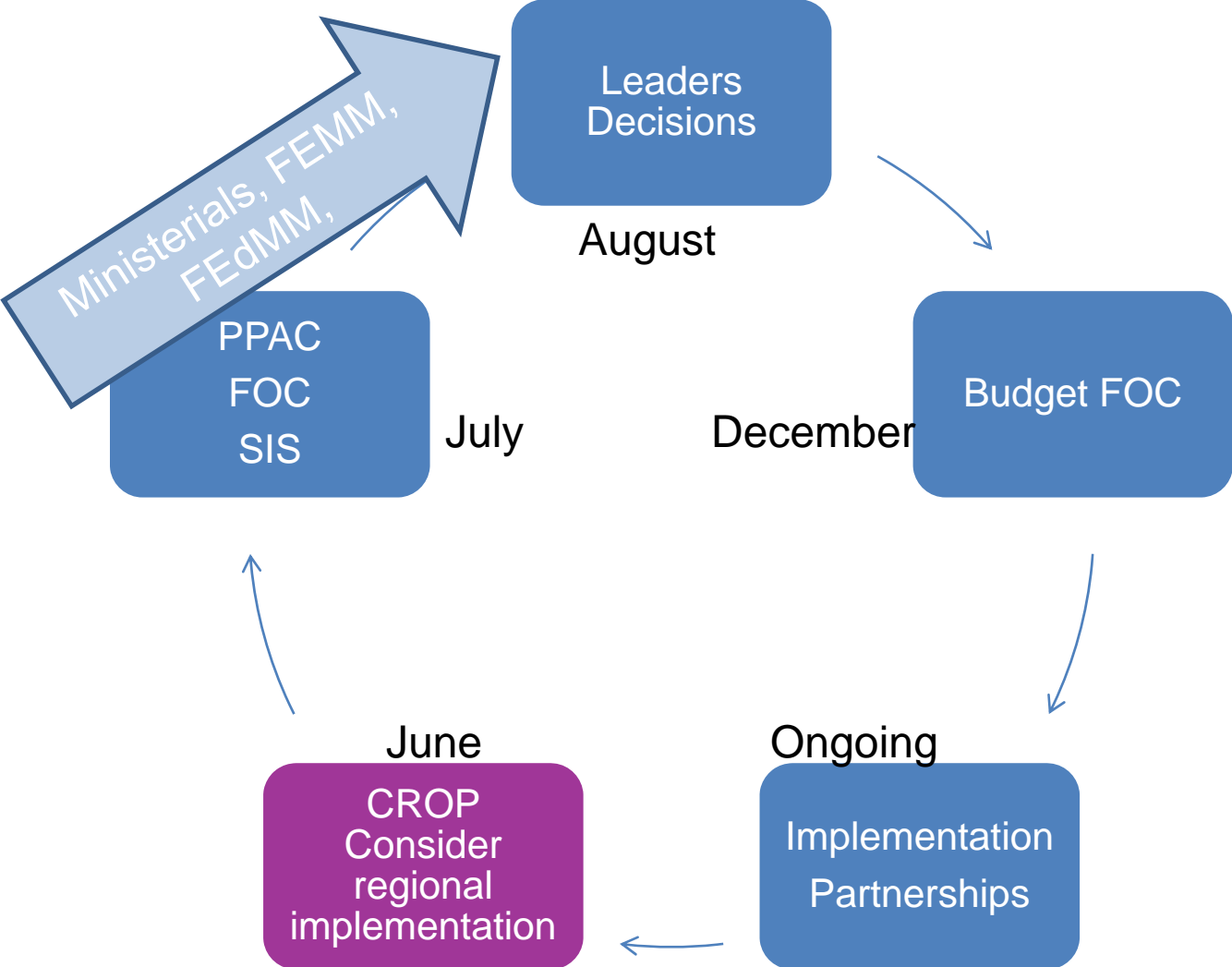
Council of Regional Organisations of the Pacific
