Background;

- Funded by:
 - Global Environment Facility (GEF)
 - Aus-Aid (Australian Government)
 - Global Climate Change Alliance (EU)
- 14 villages/sites (pilot, upscaled, replicated)
- 477 households (420 covered under the projects)
- Projects: FFD, cement base, 5,000lt rainwater-tank, installation components
- Homeowner: fascia board, guttering, tank position



Outputs/Outcomes achieved after project implementation

- Climate Change Policy Developed
- Joint National Action Plan on Climate Change Adaptation
 & Disaster risk management developed
- Community interventions through on-the-ground tangible results (water-tanks)
- Infrastructure for current & future Projects
- Assessments, reports, guidelines developed
- Tools and lessons learned for future projects

- Change in strategy as funding increased
