### **Lessons Learnt:**

- \*Take everyone on board in curriculum development:
  - Community elders: retired civil servants
  - National experts: KNEG,
  - Regional experts: SPC- GIZ, SPREP, UNESCO
  - International experts: DFAT-KEF
- Consultations in all processes
- A shift from traditional teaching methods to a more participatory, practical and personalised teaching pedagogy: Child- centred approach
- Ongoing monitoring & dialogue with school & community
- Stick to the approach to review Year 5-12 curriculum:
  - CCE aligns with ESD
