ECCA-

This project helps rural communities to adapt to climate change, but as the communities and USP are both 'learning by doing', is also research project. The major emphasis of the first phase was on the implementation of cost effective adaptation options in water and coastal sectors in six village communities in Fiji. It has been jointly implemented by USP's PACE-SD and Institute of Applied Science that started during the second half of 2006. The project is funded by the Australian International Agency for Development (AusAID). In June 2010, AusAID announced that it will put in additional funds "for over the three years to ensure the continuation of the CCA which began in 2006". This project began its second phase in July 2010, and will replicate similar project activities to those of the first in six other village communities in Fiji.
